

Sonali may soon lead a normal life

ACID attack victim Sonali Mukherjee may lead a "normal life" again after a series of surgeries are performed on her over a period of one year, doctors of a private hospital in Delhi, where she is currently being treated, said on Thursday.

Sonali underwent her first surgery at the BLK Super Specialty Hospital on Monday.

Sonali's face was disfigured

in 2003, when three youths broke into her house in Jharkhand's Dhanbad and poured acid over her.

The attack has left her completely blind and partially deaf.

According to the doctors, Sonali will undergo six to

seven surgeries spread over 12 months, following which she will be able to lead a normal life, Dr A. S. Bath, head of the plastic and reconstructive surgery department, said. Bath will head the teams of experts who will treat her.

After her over nine-year long ordeal, Sonali is hopeful of better days ahead.
